Those elected on June 4 will take office on October 1st for the ensuing 12 months.

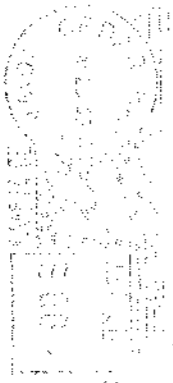
