CENTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH AND SERVICE STORY SET FOR AUGUST 20

Waldo W. Wegner, Director of Iowa State University's Center for Industrial Research and Service at Ames, will be our guest speaker next Wednesday noon, August 20th. He will relate the story behind CIRAS, which was formed in ISU's College of Engineering in 1963.

Wegner, a Professional Engineer of long and varied experience and an alumnus of ISU, was appointed CIRAS director at the time of its establishment. He formerly was associated with Loomis Bros., Inc. here in Cedar Rapids.

While in Cedar Rapids, he served as a member of the Cedar Rapids Planning Commission, the Building Code Committee and Airport Commission.

One of our newest members, Norill Rogness, is local field representative of CIRAS, and was instrumental in arranging this program.
