People who wonder where the younger generation is headed would do well to consider where it came from.

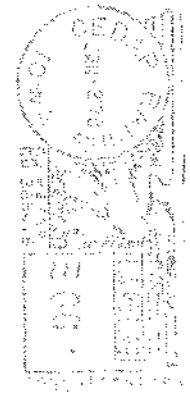
I know you know, but -
