LAST WEEK

Sixteen Iowa industries which most of us had never even heard of--that's what Waldo Wegner showed via slides and described last Wednesday. Norril Rogness introduced his boss. The Center for Industrial Research and Service was established by Iowa State University in 1963. Professional Engineer and former Cedar Rapiidian Waldo Wegner, an ISU graduate, was selected to head the organization. (While living in Cedar Rapids, Wegner worked for the Portland Cement Company and the Loomis Construction Company.) The goals of CIRAS are to help Iowa industry grow and, no doubt what is more important, make a profit. The state is divided into six CIRAS districts. Norril heads the Southeast District with headquarters at 4401 Sixth Street SW, Cedar Rapids.
