## LAST WEEK

Almost 90 members, their queens and guests heard the Key Club, Circle K Club special program. Carl Hayes, Governor Elect from Marshalltown, whose Marshalltown Club has formed Circle K and a Key Club in Marshalltown, introduced Tim Blount, a Key Club Lt. Gov. from Newton, Iowa.

Tim pointed out that the high school Key Club benefits the community, the club members, the school and Kiwanis. He described Key Clubs as a fastly growing club in the country. Tim also outlined some of steps which might be taken in forming a Key Club in a high school.
