Roosevelt Hotel---Dr. Myron L. Koenig, visiting professor at Mt. Mercy College, speaking on the many factors which go into the "Training of Our Diplomats".

Dr. Koenig did his undergraduate work at Grinnell College and continued on to do graduate work at the University of Iowa to earn M.A. and Ph.D. degrees in History and Political Science. He has taught at Grinnell, Coe, the U of Iowa and George Washington University in this country and lectured at some thirty universities in the United Kingdom and the Universities of Copenhagen, West Berlin and Paris. Lecture engagements in the United States have taken him to more than 250 campuses from coast to coast.

Dr. Koenig joined the Foreign Service Institute of the Department of State in 1958; became Dean of Foreign Affairs in 1965 and retired from the U.S. Government service in August, 1970.
