According to the 1971 Annual Report, Henry Harnischfeger is President and Chairman of the Board. The senior Harnischfeger - Walter - is Honorary Chairman.

Wherever something big is going on you will find "P & H" worldwide. Mining, bridges, dams, expressways and modular housing are a few of the projects which utilize their giant cranes and shovels. But they have one product line that sort of bothers me. That robot truck which is capable of locating, lifting and delivering its load to a destination without human help.
